I am shocked and deeply concerned about the latest report of a third leakage along the Petronas Sabah-Sarawak Pipeline (PSSP), which occurred at Long Segaman, Lawas. Thank God there were no casualties.

This incident will cause more uneasiness and concern for many of us who live in close proximity with the said PSSP.

In the last briefing given by Petronas after the second incident at Long Luping, I was made to understand that stringent procedures were established to ensure such leakages could be detected in advance. Now it looks like these safety measures or the monitoring process are not effective and functioning.

Again I request for a thorough investigation and that I will be briefed of the same soonest.
