FRAUD CASES INVOLVING PROJECT TENDER MINISTRY OF WORKS

Kuala Lumpur, Thursday, April 7, 2016 - The Ministry of Works (KKR) has received complaints on the fraudulent works of scammers using the Work Ministry's name from the public, contractors and construction's industry players.

The scammers start with a phone call purporting to be from the KKR or with a mail from a cloned address, masquerading and offering a direct negotiation tenders under the name of ministry of works.

The fraudster even use fake letterhead of the KKR and JKR to the extent of disguising as KKR officers and request victim to put a certain amount of money into his personal account as a down payment in order to obtain a contract from KKR or Public Works Department (JKR).

KKR had made police reports on April 7, 2016, at the Dang Wangi Police Station, Kuala Lumpur as a precautionary measure and seriousness on this fraud issue.
