MALAYSIA–KOREA SIGN MOU TO ENHANCE PARTNERSHIP IN INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT AND CONSTRUCTION TECHNOLOGIES

KUALA LUMPUR - The Ministry of Works Malaysia (MOW) today commemorates the successful signing of a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure and Transport (MOLIT) of the Republic of Korea, marking a significant step forward in strengthening bilateral cooperation in infrastructure development and advanced construction technologies.
